## Little Green Thumbs Vegetable Guide

This is a planting guide to the vegetable seeds provided in Little Green Thumbs seeds packets. The Days to Maturity may vary depending on the conditions in your classroom. Most seeds can be started in pellets or direct sown into containers if needed. Please use this as a guide but we encourage experimentation!
